
Easter Themed Basket Craft

- 4. Fill your box with Easter goodies.




Easter Weaving

You will need:

- A4 print out of Easter Egg template
- A4 print out of coloured Strips template
- A4 coloured paper (three different colours)
- Scissors

- Glue
- Glue spreader
- Optional: lengths of colourful ribbon





In preparation, print the Easter egg template on to A4 sized paper. Cut out the egg shapes, following the guidelines.



Fold the Easter egg in half along the centre line. Carefully cut along the vertical lines with the scissors.



Print out the coloured strips template and place over the top of two or three sheets of coloured paper. Carefully cut along the lines to make the strips of paper. Alternatively, you may use lengths of colourful ribbon cut to size.



Using one strip of paper, thread horizontally through the cut gaps in the Easter egg. The strip should go (from left to right) **under** the first piece of paper and **over** the following piece of paper. Follow this 'under, over' pattern until the strip is through all of the gaps.





Easter Weaving



Thread the second piece of paper horizontally above the first strip. This time the strip should go (from left to right) **over** the first piece of paper and **under** the following piece of paper. Follow this 'over, under' pattern until the strip is through all of the gaps.



Keep repeating steps 4 and 5 until the Easter egg is filled with strips of paper. After threading each strip of paper, gently push down to the bottom of the Easter egg.



On one side of the Easter egg, glue the strips of paper on the edges to the egg. Repeat on the other side.




Finally, carefully cut around the outline of the egg. Make sure that all of the strips are cut off.

Chocolate Easter Nests Recipe



Ingredients

Cocoa Powder – 2 tablespoons, level

Golden Syrup – 2 tablespoons, level

Dark Chocolate – 150g, dark, broken into pieces

Margarine – 50g, soft

Shredded Wheat – 4 biscuit(s), crushed (you could substitute with cornflakes or rice crispies)

Chocolate Mini Eggs – 108g (36 individual eggs)

Instructions

- 1. Put 12 paper bun cases into a 12-hole bun tin.
- 2. Put the cocoa powder, syrup, chocolate and margarine into a medium saucepan. Heat gently, stirring, until melted and smooth.
- 3. Add the crushed Shredded Wheat biscuits and stir until coated. Share the mixture between the bun cases, making a depression in the middle with the back of a teaspoon to form a nest shape. Finish off each chocolate nest with 3 tiny chocolate Easter eggs. Chill until set.
