

Group Visits to Holy Trinity Church - 2026

All groups of 6 persons or more need to be approved in advance by either the vicar, the vergger, or other Church officer.

Option 1

Ideally the group should take advantage of one of our in-house produced tours. This is led by an experienced member from Holy Trinity Church. This concentrates on our connection with C.S. Lewis and lasts for around one hour (this can be varied according to the group's schedule). The tour/talk is basically in three parts. Firstly, the group learn about the history of the church and about some of its main features. We then explore in some detail our connection with Lewis looking at areas such as when he came to the church, where he preferred to sit in the building, his relationship with the other church members etc. After a time for photographs, we finish with a visit to the churchyard looking primarily at the Lewis grave and that of Mrs Janie King Moore. We do ask for a donation that goes towards the maintenance of our building and ministry: this is currently **£7.00 per person.**

Option 2

Should the group have their own qualified tour leader, visiting is possible (with permission) but we do request a donation per head. This goes towards the considerable running costs of leaving the church open for visitors to enjoy and maintaining items such as the Lewis grave. Please note that a church officer may not be present and that all the church's facilities may not be available on the day. The recommended donation for 2026 is **£5 per individual.** This should be paid by bank transfer a minimum of one week before the visit.
